Who is the Level 2 Award in Principles of COSHH (Containment of Substances Hazardous to Health) for?

This qualification is designed for those who use substances hazardous to health at work. It introduces candidates to substances, the risks and controls available, and outlines what to expect from a control of substances hazardous to health (COSHH) assessment. The qualification will prepare employees to contribute to the safer use of hazardous substances in their workplaces.

What are the modules?

Definition and types of substances hazardous to health in the workplace • Health effects of hazardous substances and their causes • COSHH assessments and control options • Responsibilities imposed by the Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations 2002

Certification

Candidates who successfully complete the 30 question multiple choice examination (1hr) will receive a CIEH Level 2 certificate in Principles of COSHH.
