

# **HSE 2 Day (12hr) Pediatric First Aid course**

## **Who is the course for?**

This course is designed for care workers including child minders, nannies, pre-school and nursery workers and people working with young children in general. The course is in line with the Statutory Framework for the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) and meets OFSTED criteria.

## **Entry requirements**

There are no formal academic entry requirements in order to attain this qualification; however candidates should be physically and mentally capable of carrying out the first aid techniques taught.

## **Course structure**

To achieve a successful pass in this course, learners will be expected to:

- First Aid Priorities
- Regulations, Recording and Reporting
- Managing Incidents, Basic Life Support-Adult, Child & Baby
- Choking
- Casualty Examination
- Unconsciousness
- Anaphylaxis • Fractures
- Control of Bleeding & Shock
- Asthma
- Eye and Ear Injuries
- Burns and Scalds
- Childhood Illnesses including Meningitis and Febrile Convulsions

## **Assessment method**

The course is continually assessed over the 2 days.

## **Pass marks**

To pass this course the candidate must prove, over the course of the 2 days that they have the knowledge and skill to be able to carry out and treat the conditions and techniques taught.

## **Course duration**

2 Days (12hrs) the qualification lasts for 3 Years. The HSE recommend annual refresher training.

## **How much does the course cost?**

The course costs £140 per person Incl VAT
